Notice is given in accordance with section 42 of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 and the School Organisation Code that Newport City Council, having consulted such persons as required, proposes to alter Caerleon Lodge Hill Primary School, Roman Way, Caerleon to establish a generic 10-place Learning Resource Base class for pupils aged between 4 years and 11 years with additional learning needs. This school is an English-medium community school maintained by Newport City Council.

The Council undertook a period of consultation before deciding to publish this proposal. It is proposed to implement this proposal on 29th April 2019.

The establishment of the Learning Resource Base will support the increasing demand for primary specialist education provision across Newport via an inclusive approach to enable pupils with additional learning needs to be taught within a mainstream school environment. Admission to this provision will be based on an assessment of need as determined by the Chief Education Officer.

The Council has a Home to School Transport policy which provides free transport to eligible pupils of statutory school age. This provision will not be affected by this proposal. Further information in relation to this policy is available on the Council website.

Within a period of 28 days after the date of publication of these proposals, that is to say by Monday 4th February 2019 any person may object in writing or by email to the proposals.
