- A document stimulating/rewarding the use of public transport or cycling for commuting by employees

We currently have several supported living schemes in the local area, and on average, most of the staff we employ use public transport or car share with each other. Priory support staff should use public transport, and we have a cycle-to-work scheme to encourage cycling, which is promoted via our Priory Perks scheme that is available to all our staff.

- A statement detailing how many care providers would be present on average

We have estimated that two staff members will be on duty at all times and sometimes more during the day, depending on the needs of the referrals we receive from the local authority.

- A breakdown of typical shift times

We normally operate a shift pattern of 8 am—8 pm and then 8 pm—8 am the next morning.

- Average visitor numbers and timings –

Normally, family members would visit on a weekend. We encourage tenants to visit their families; many of the people we support don't have families.
