Ref.: Construction Traffic Routing Plan for Plot 7, Queensway, Llanwern

Dear Francesca Sanders,

We are writing to Newport City Council to provide details of the construction traffic routing plan for the development at Plot 7, Queensway, Llanwern. All contractors and visitors will be instructed on the designated approach routes to ensure compliance with the Newport Air Quality Management Areas (AQMAs) 2018. This will help prevent significant adverse effects on air quality, in line with Policy GP7, and ensure no detrimental impact on local amenity, as outlined in Policy GP2.

From the north contractors will come via the M4 junction 24, then the A48 towards Plot 7, Queensway, Llanwern to avoid non M4 air quality management areas.

From the West contractors will come via the M4 junction 28, then the A48 towards Plot 7, Queensway, Llanwern to avoid non M4 air quality management areas.

From the east contractors will come via the M4 junction 23A then the A4810 towards Plot 7, Queensway, Llanwern to avoid non M4 air quality management areas.

As part of the induction process for contractors at Plot 7, Queensway, Llanwern, they will be required to document their origin and destination points, on our induction platform (Inndex). This will allow us to monitor the total mileage travelled and the mode of transport used. By tracking this information, TSL can identify opportunities for contractors to share transportation, reducing the overall air pollution associated with their commutes.
