Thank you for consulting us on this application; consequently we have reviewed the detailed information contained on your website and can **confirm that the proposal will require archaeological mitigation.**

We have consulted the regional Historic Environment Record (HER) and note that the proposed development lies within an area of multi-period activity. The proposed works are just outside the Archaeologically Sensitive Area of Newport. The property runs along a known Roman road to the south, in addition to close proximity to the cremations and Roman cemetery. To the west of the works, a findspot of Roman material was also found during a development by a local including a pot, fragments of tegula, possibly two pieces of tegula and two worked stones. A review of the 1st – 4th Edition historic Ordnance Survey maps (1882; 1901; 1920; 1936) shows an open field with no archaeological features with the exception of a spring.

The proposal includes a new dwelling and associated works. The works are moderate in scale, and does include changes that will disturb archaeological features. With our understanding of the historic environment in the immediate area, there is some potential that significant buried archaeological remains associated with the Roman period will be encountered during the course of the proposed works.

Therefore, it is our recommendation that a condition requiring the applicant to submit a detailed written scheme of investigation for a programme of archaeological work to protect the archaeological resource should be attached to any consent granted by your Members.

We envisage that this programme of work would take the form of a watching brief during the groundworks required for the development, with detailed contingency arrangements including the provision of sufficient time and resources to ensure that any archaeological features or finds that are located are properly investigated and recorded; it should include provision for any sampling that may prove necessary, post-excavation recording and assessment and reporting and possible publication of the results. To ensure adherence to the recommendations we recommend that the condition should be worded in a manner similar to model condition 24 given in Welsh Government Circular 016/2014.

No development shall take place until the applicant, or their agents or successors in title, has secured agreement for a written scheme of historic environment mitigation which has been submitted by the applicant and approved by the local planning authority. Thereafter, the programme of work will be fully carried out in accordance with the requirements and standards of the written scheme.

Reason: *To identify and record any features of archaeological interest discovered during the works, in order to mitigate the impact of the works on the archaeological resource.*

We also recommend that a note should be attached to the planning consent explaining that:

The archaeological work must be undertaken to the appropriate Standard and Guidance set by Chartered Institute for Archaeologists (CIfA), (www.archaeologists.net/codes/ifa) and it is recommended that it is carried out either by a CIfA Registered Organisation (www.archaeologists.net/ro) or an accredited Member.
