Hi Geraint,

Have you had a re-consultation response from NRW on the revised lighting plan for the above site? I requested in my previous comments that the River Usk SAC boundary be shown on the updated plan, this has not been done and so it is difficult to assess how far the light spill encroaches in to the protected site. However, it appears as if there are still unacceptably high levels (over 0.5 lux) along the water front “behind” the lighting columns – can baffles/cowls be added to direct the light away from the river bank?
