Hi Ruth,

I can confirm no significant concerns with the ending of groundwater monitoring (for the purposes of identifying impact via earthworks as outlined in your letter report ref:RH/10411/Let25 dated 30/08/16) . The proposal to continue testing imported fill as per the remediation strategy is considered adequate. However, would have to caveat this by suggesting that this may need to be revisited should any fundamental changes occur i.e. significant change in nature of earthworks, pollution incident, identification of any previously unknown contamination etc.
